

**CENTRAL MASSACHUSETTS AGENCY ON AGING

Effective October 1, 2015, **26 grants** in the amount of **\$2,099,877** were awarded to **13 non-profit** organizations serving elders throughout Central Massachusetts. These federal grants, authorized under the Older Americans Act, are targeted to meet the highest priority needs of persons 60 years of age and older. A volunteer allocations committee reviewed all grant applications and recommended funding for the following programs. The Advisory Council and Board of Directors approved the recommendations.
