The Worcester County Elder Abuse Prevention Roundtable is a coalition of elder serving professionals that includes law enforcement, elder service agencies, sexual and domestic violence service providers, and community service organizations. This coalition is the outcome of a 2002 training grant through the **Stop Abuse and Sexual Assault Against Older Individuals or Individuals with Disabilities Program.**

Since 2005 the coalition has continued to work to provide training, education and outreach to help to prevent and reduce elder abuse in Worcester County.
